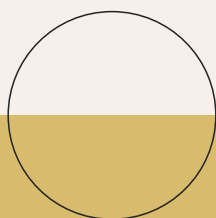

THE DESTINATION

WEDDING TIMELINE

12+ MONTHS

Start thinking about what your wedding day looks like!

Then create a budget around all the must haves.

Buy a wedding binder to keep all correspondence, inspo etc....

Draft a Guest List, Divide into A and B group

(Note: According to The Knot, if you invite 100, less than half will attend)

Browse [Pinterest](#) and create board with ideas

Reach Out for Help (Hire a DW travel advisor and/or planner)

Decide if you will have a Legal or Symbolic Ceremony.

If you are planning a [Legal Ceremony](#), start compiling documents.

Choose a [Destination/Resort](#) & Wedding Package.

Confirm wedding date with deposit. Allow for up to a 1 week for confirmation.

Work with Travel Advisor to secure guest room block.

Make initial deposit for group.

Schedule engagement photos if necessary.

9-11 MONTHS

Choose Your Wedding Party. Check out these [cool ideas](#) to tell them.

Determine if you will have additional wedding events

(Ex: Welcome Cocktail, Brunch, Back home reception etc.)

Create a [wedding website](#)

Start a Private/Closed Facebook Group for All Guests

Set up a wedding/[honeymoon registry](#).

Send out [SAVE THE DATES](#). Use code: TravelBash to save 20%.

Finalize Guest List and Send to Travel Advisor

[Apply or renew passports](#). [Check expiration date!](#)

Schedule Option On-Site Resort Visit

(Many resorts will apply credit to your wedding package)

Get to Know Your On-site coordinator.

If you want to start a workout routine, here is the time to get faithful to the old gym!

8-10 MONTHS

Create music playlist on Tidal/Spotify/Apple Music etc.

Hire A Photographer if not using onsite vendor.

Start brainstorming photo ideas. Decide if you will TRASH THE DRESS.

Let's shop! The search is on for your wedding attire and party. Check out these tips!

If you are planning an additional honeymoon, schedule this now. (We like Sandals Island Honeymoon Hop.)

6-8 MONTHS

Start brainstorming ideas for ceremony and reception.

(Note: Onsite coordinator might not reach out any earlier.)

Book Flights *(if not booking within package)* Check out our flight guidelines.

Finalize RSVPs and ensure that guests are making payments.

Make any final wedding attire orders.

Schedule any Bridal Party Excursions and/or special events with loved ones.

Start thinking about hair/makeup/nails/grooming. Make appointments early.

4-6 MONTHS

Start finalizing ceremony & reception details with on-site property wedding coordinator.

Finalize décor, flower, menu and cake selections with on-site coordinator.

Shop for Welcome Bags Items.

Confirm that all guests are on track with payments & deadlines.

Order any wedding related products you need for wedding day Purchase any wedding accessories.

Start thinking about vows.

Start facial routine and nutrition plan if nec.

3-4 MONTHS

Shop for Wedding Rings

For legal ceremonies, send paperwork.

Choose and purchase wedding party gifts. *(We say ditch them and choose an excursion instead.)*

Confirm final ceremony details *(songs, reading, day of events)*

Confirm shot list with photographer. *(Share Pinterest board with them)*

Confirm final guest list. Release any unnecessary rooms with hotel/resort.

Schedule fitting for wedding attire

Purchase Parents gift *(optional)*

Purchase fiancé gift *(optional)*

Hair & Makeup Trials!!! *(Test that new color/lashes/ eye color)*

2-3 MONTHS

Finalize vows

Finalize Any Group Excursion Details with Travel Designer. Finalize all wedding day itineraries.

Finalize any wedding balances and due dates.

Schedule final fittings for wedding.

Purchase a Wally Bag or Garment bag to carry your dress.

Maybe a tan for some or teeth whitening for others.

Send out welcome newsletter.

1 MONTH

Assign responsibilities to wedding party and other guests.

Pick up wedding attire.

Review Travel Documents.

Send announcement details to local newspaper (*optional*)

Confirm beauty appointments. Including a trial run once you arrive at the resort.

1-2 WEEKS

Start Packing (*Do not wait until the week of the wedding*)

Make sure Brows are on point!

Prepare tips in envelopes for vendors.

Exchange some cash for country's currency. (*optional, always carry USD*)

Make sure you have chargers/plugs etc.

Do NOT, I repeat DO NOT stay up all night! :)

UPON ARRIVAL

Enjoy a cocktail. You have arrived in paradise!

Meet with Onsite Wedding Coordinator to review any last minute details. *(Usually 2-3 days out from wedding)*

Deliver Welcome Bags & Gifts *(Resorts will do this for like \$5 fee per room)*

Enjoy some alone time before everyone makes their way to the resort/hotel!!!

DAY BEFORE

Limit Alcohol (for bloating purposes)

Have a full healthy breakfast.

Get ready, make sure to have fun, you are about to go from Miss to Mrs.
