* Airfare costs vary significantly depending on several factors. Additional expenses may include optional trip-cancellation insurance.

** All Temple Japan study abroad students are required to have a working smart phone (either a U.S. number or a local Japanese number) for the duration of the program.

*** COVID-19 testing required for return to the U.S. is not covered by Temple's international travel medical insurance.

**** Non-Temple students who require a transcript will order one through TUPortal. Further instructions can be found on [Temple's Registrar's website](#).

In addition to the items above, you should budget additional money if you plan to undertake personal travel outside of Tokyo. **Depending on local and international conditions, you may be prohibited from traveling outside of Japan during your semester abroad.**
