*All students are required to have sufficient health coverage while attending WIU. Any uninsured students are required to purchase WIU provided primary coverage. Students with qualifying personal health insurance have the option to use their existing coverage and only purchase athletic coverage at a reduced cost. A student's primary insurance coverage must meet predetermined guidelines. Proof of insurance is required of all students. If approved, the athletic insurance (required) is \$1,098/year. Please obtain approval prior to purchasing an insurance policy.

- Federal student loans have to be repaid; repayment begins within 6 months after the student graduates or drops below half time.
- Unsubsidized student loans accrue interest while the student is in school.
- There are lifetime federal student loan and PELL limits, if you are a transfer students and you believe you may be close to your limits, please contact the Financial Aid Office.

Federal Parent PLUS Loans

Parent PLUS Loans are federal loans available to parents up to the cost of attendance. They can be conveniently applied for online at studentaid.gov. The application requires a soft credit check. If the parent is approved, they can borrow an amount up to the student's cost of attendance minus the financial aid they receive. If the parent is denied, the student is eligible for an additional unsubsidized loan. Freshman and sophomore students are eligible for \$4,000/year and junior and seniors are eligible for \$5,000/year in the additional unsubsidized loan.

Florida Prepaid

If you have a Florida Prepaid Tuition Program, send a copy of your student identification card to the Business Office. The 2020-2021 rates are shown below. Webber is a private university approved for the Florida Prepaid Program. Please contact the FLPP Program for a transfer form to designate Webber. (Florida Prepaid College Plan amounts are subject to change for 2021-2022)
