

# Family Tree Project:

Using what we have learned in class, create a video to explain your family tree in American Sign Language (ASL). You must use correct vocabulary and grammar. Post your family tree video on Blackboard.

## Requirements:

- ✓ Must have both sides of your family
- ✓ Need to have 3 generations (grandparents, parents, yourself/siblings, or yourself/siblings, your children, your grandchildren).
- ✓ Students must use locatives/referents and use role shifting.
  - For example:
    - My dad's dad's name is Wint Jr.
    - My Dad's mom's name is Barbara
    - My dad's name is Wint III
    - My dad is an only child
    - My mom's dad's name is Gary
    - My mom's mom's name is Patty
    - My mom's name is Lynn
    - My mom has 3 siblings; one brother and two sisters
    - I have no sisters and 2 brothers. My brothers' names are Buddy and Skylar.
- ✓ You need to include 3 facts about yourself.
  - I love playing all sports. My absolute favorite sports are soccer, volleyball, and tennis.
  - My favorite color is light blue
  - I ran the Disneyland Princess ½ Marathon. I am training to run the Disney's Coast to Coast ½ Marathons in 2013 and 2014.
- ✓ Your major at AWC

## Extra Credit:

You may do more than 3 generations (each additional completed generation is 2 points) or additional facts about yourself (max of 4 additional facts for 1 point each).
