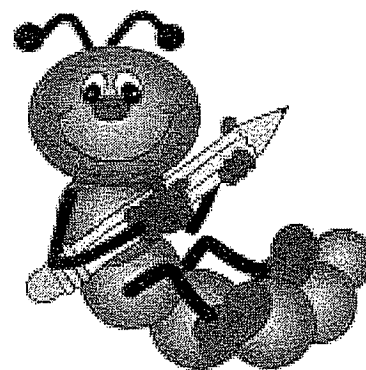
- No reading logs need to be collected or turned in from September 25 to October 27th.

This report is to be done at home and not at school

In the packet given to your student, are all the materials you will need to create your lap book report.

Items found in your packet include

- Directions for assembling lap book
- Tan colored file folder for use as lap book
- Copies of each section to glue onto lap book



Items you will need on your own

- Glue
- Crayons, markers or colored pencils
- Scissors
- Pencil

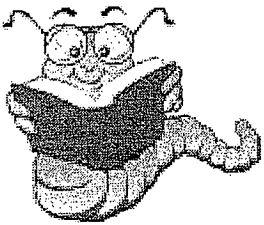
You will need to read your book first and then use it to help you fill in the corresponding sections. I highly advise that you color and write on all of your pieces before you cut them out. Once you have written and colored all of the sections, then cut them out and glue together as a final product.

Directions

- 1) Read fiction book in your A.R reading level.
- 2) Write in all the separate pieces in your packet related to your book.
 - a. Please **DO NOT** write your sections in cursive.
- 3) Be creative and color in every piece.
 - a. Be careful about coloring and do not color over your writing. I need to be able to clearly read what you wrote.
- 4) Cut all pieces out and follow directions on how to glue into your lap book.
 - a. Cut and glue them down neatly and make sure all edges are glued down.
- 5) Turn in completed project on or before the due date.

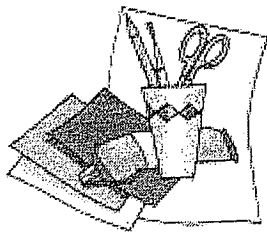
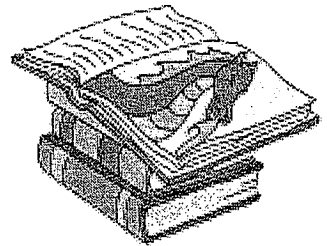
Grading of report

- Neatness counts!!! Please take your time on your handwriting and coloring. Please do not use cursive yet on your assignment as we have not finished all of the letters in class. Points will be taken off if I cannot read any words or if I find any incomplete sentences. I am also looking to see how you glued all of your pieces and if you made sure to glue down all of the corners and take your time assembling the lap book.
- I am also looking on how well you followed directions. The pieces should be in the correct place based on the direction given in your packet.
- If I read your entire lap book I want to be able to understand what you read and what the book is about.



The goal of this project is to have fun reading a book of your choice and really diving into the material and understanding what is going on in the story. Please help your student with difficult words and or questions related to the story.

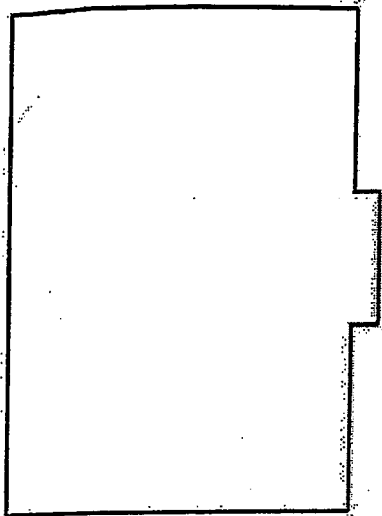

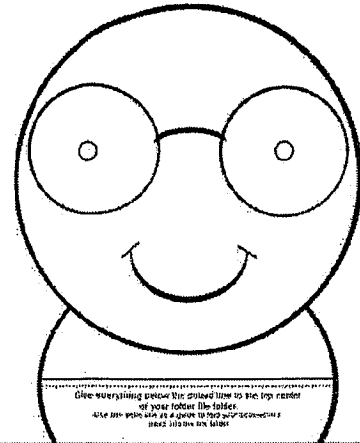
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LAP BOOK INSTRUCTIONS

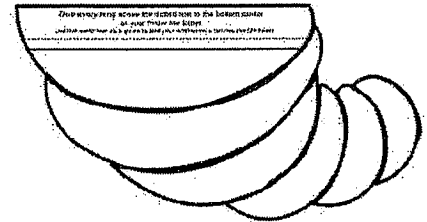
Bookworm's Head

- Step 1** - Color the bookworm's head and neck (do not color below the dotted line).
- Step 2** - Cut out.
- Step 3** - Glue below the dotted line and attach to the outside top center of your Lap Book.



Tail

- Step 1** - Color the bookworm's tail (do not color above the dotted line).
- Step 2** - Cut out.
- Step 3** - Glue above the dotted line and attach to the outside bottom center of your Lap Book.



Front Cover

Left Side

- Step 1** - Write the book title and author's name into the appropriate boxes; shade the background in color.
- Step 2** - Color the worm's fingers.
- Step 3** - Cut out the rectangle and glue to the left side of your Lap Book's Cover.

Right Side

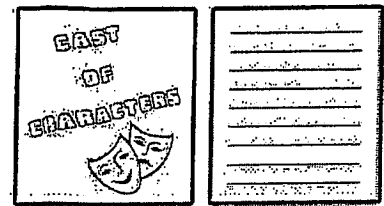
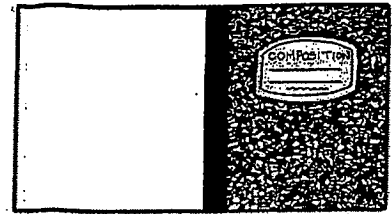
- Step 1** - Write the genre of the book and your name into the appropriate boxes; shade the background in color.
- Step 2** - Color the worm's fingers.
- Step 3** - Cut out the entire rectangle and glue to the right side of you Lap Book's cover.

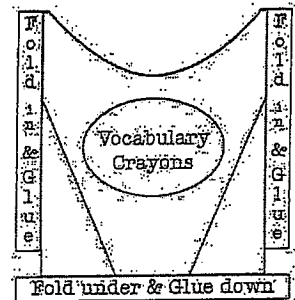
Composition Notebook

- Step 1 - Color the "Cast of Characters" sheet and cut out.
- Step 2 - List all the major characters on the blank sheet and cut out.
- Step 3 - Cut out the Composition Notebook and fold in half.
- Step 4 - Glue the "Cast of Characters" sheet on the inside (left) of the Composition Notebook.
- Step 5 - Glue the "list of characters" sheet to the inside (right) of the Composition Notebook.
- Step 6 - Glue the back of your folded Composition Notebook to the inside of your Lap Book.



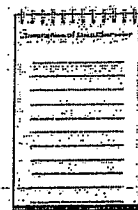
Crayon Box

- Step 1 - Color the "Vocabulary Crayons" box (do not color the "fold and glue" tabs).
- Step 2 - Cut out.
- Step 3 - Fold the tabs (inward/under).
- Step 4 - Glue the tabs to attach the Crayon Box to the inside of your Lap Book. (Remember: Only glue the tabs so that the Crayon Box becomes a pouch)



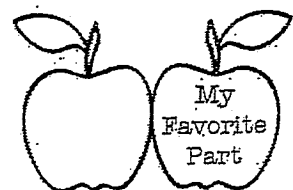
Memo Pad

- Step 1 - Write a description of the main character on the memo pad.
- Step 2 - Cut out and glue to the inside of your Lap book.



Apple

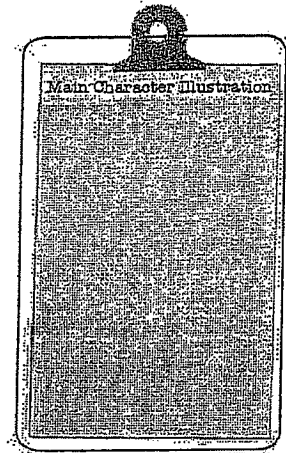
- Step 1 - Color the right side of the apple.
- Step 2 - Cut out and fold in half.
- Step 3 - Write your favorite part of the book on the inside of the apple.
- Step 4 - Glue the back of your folded apple to the inside of your Lap Book.

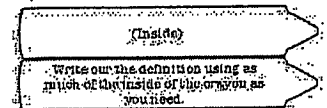
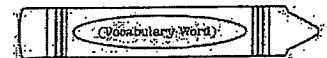
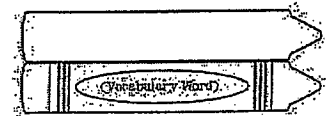
Clipboard

- Step 1 - Draw a picture of the main character on the clipboard.
- Step 2 - Cut out and glue to the inside of your Lap Book.



Vocabulary Crayons

- Step 1- As you are reading, jot down 5 vocabulary words that you do not know the meaning of.
- Step 2- Write one word in each crayon oval.
- Step 3- Color each crayon a different color.
- Step 4- Cut out crayons.
- Step 5- Fold each crayon in half.
- Step 6- Write the definition of each word and a sentence using the word inside your folded crayon.
- Step 7- Place your folded crayons inside your crayon box pouch.



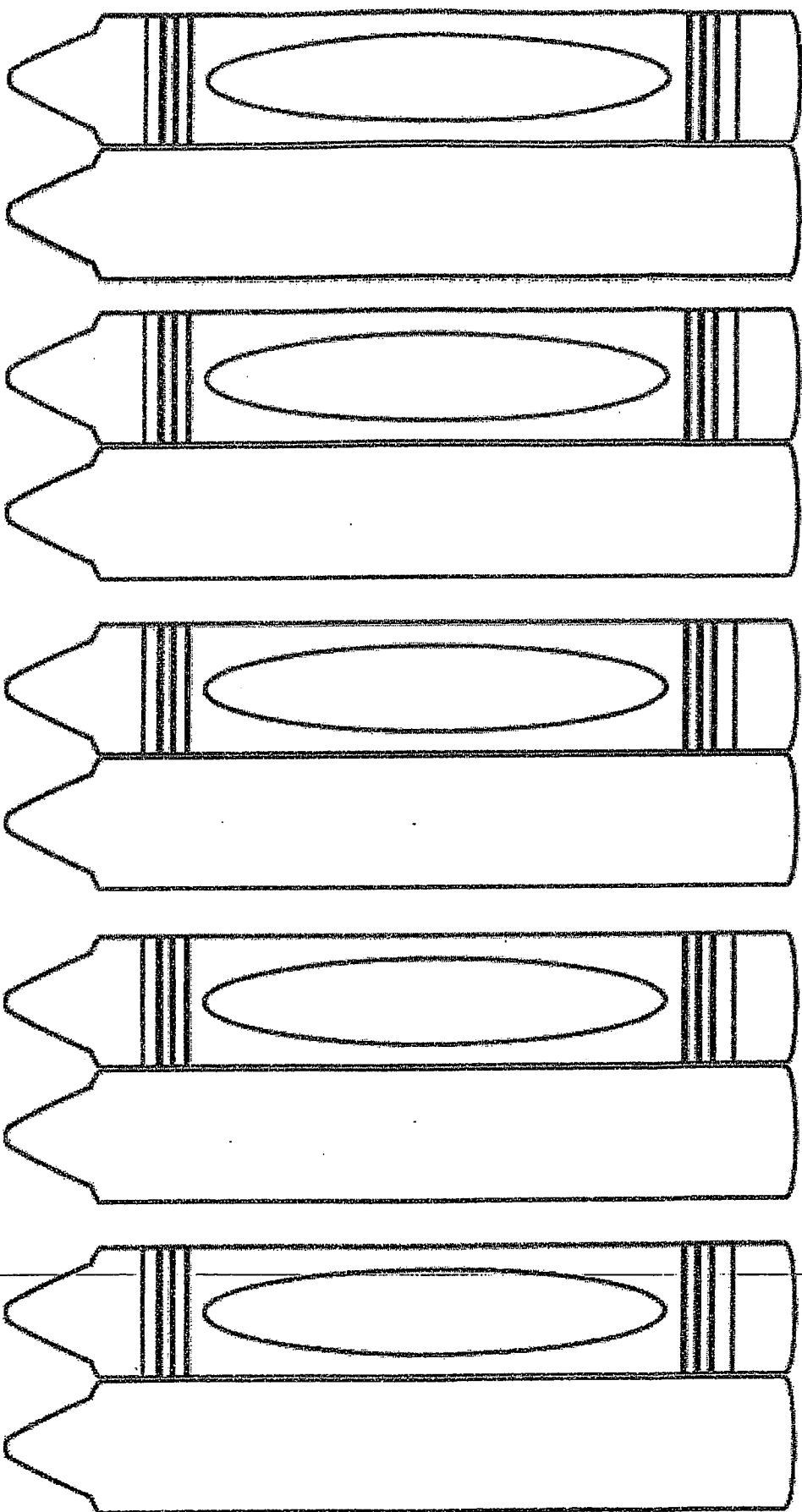
