

RESUME OF JUDGE ALBERT P. DOVER (ret):

Judge Dover (ret) has completed over 250 mediations in the last several years. The vast majority of those cases involved complex Will and Trust or other familial disputes as well as difficult commercial and civil disputes. His very high success rate is predicated on both extensive training in mediating high conflict matters and personal qualities, including patience, sincerity, wit, wisdom and compassion.

ADR services include Mediation, Med/Arb, Early Neutral Evaluation, and Confidential Listener Services.
