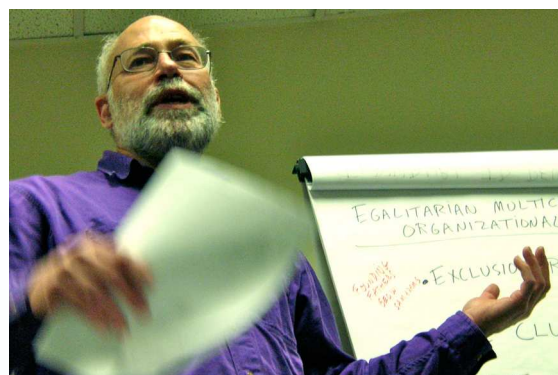
Consulting with Groups and Organizations
