In awarding the rank of Eagle Scout, the BOR seeks written evidence that the Scouts live their daily lives in accordance with the Scouting principles as exemplified in the Scout Oath and the Scout Law:

SCOUT OATH *On my honor, I will do my best to do my duty to God and my country and to obey the Scout Law; To help other people at all times; To keep myself physically strong, mentally awake, and morally straight.*

SCOUT LAW *A Scout is Trustworthy, Loyal, Helpful, Friendly, Courteous, Kind, Obedient, Cheerful, Thrifty, Brave, Clean, and Reverent.*

In addition to the Scout Oath and the Scout Law, will you please consider in your appraisal the following items as applicable:

- Regular participation in Religious Observances, and respect for the religious convictions of others.
- Leadership in Church, School, Community and Job activities.
- Cheerful sharing of home duties and responsibilities.
- General scholastic record in school.
- Careful use of his own and other people’s property.
- Preparedness to meet the challenges of life, as compared to his peers.

There are two options on format for your input to the Eagle Scout BOR:

- Write a standard reference letter addressing the topics mentioned above. Be sure to include your name, address, phone number, and relationship to the Scout, i.e., Parent, Educator, Religious Leader, Employer, or Other, **OR**
- Complete the attached Character Profile Form.

Brave – Face difficult situations even when you feel afraid. Do what you think is right despite what others may be doing or saying.					
Clean – Keep your body and mind fit. Help keep your home and community clean.					
Reverent – Be reverent toward God. Be faithful in your religious duties. Respect the beliefs of others.
