

# Christmas Gift Tags

## Fabric Requirements (makes 9 tags) :

- ¼ yard of White Dots
- ¼ yard of Red Stripe
- ¼ yard of Green Swirls

## You will also need:

- 1 ½ yards of Fusible Web
- 2 yards of cord or ribbon
- OPTIONAL- (9) ¼" Eyelets

# Christmas Gift Tags

3" x 5 1/2"

Please read all instructions before starting. Measurement on borders are approximate, measure your quilt top before cutting.

## Cutting Instructions:

### White Dots

- Cut six 4" x 6" rectangles (3 for label fronts and 3 for label backs)
- See instructions to cut stocking and ornament parts

### Red Stripe

- Cut six 4" x 6" rectangles (3 for label fronts and 3 for label backs)
- See instructions to cut stocking and tree parts

### Green Swirls

- Cut six 4" x 6" rectangles (3 for label fronts and 3 for label backs)
- See instructions to cut tree and ornament parts


## Assembly Instructions

1. Refer to the manufacturer's instructions to trace the tree, stocking and ornament templates onto the paper side of the fusible web.
2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
3. Using the placement drawing and an applique pressing sheet to assemble the tree, stocking and ornament: NOTE: if you do not have an applique pressing sheet, assemble each item onto the center of a 4" x 6" rectangle of your choice.
4. Press the assembled tree, stocking or tree onto the center of one 4" x 6" rectangle of your choice to make the gift tag front. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.
5. Press fusible web to the wrong side of the gift tag front. Place one plain 4" x 6" rectangle (label back) on top of the fused label front, wrong sides together (with the fusible web sandwiched between the two fabrics). Press the layers together to make one label.
6. Place the Gift Tag Template on top of the layered label and trace around the template. Make sure to mark the hole for the cord onto the tag as well. Cut out the gift tag and the hole.
7. Stitch around the gift tag edge using a decorative stitch such as a satin or buttonhole stitch or use a straight stitch an 1/8" around the edges
8. For the hole, either stitch around the hole or use a 1/4" eyelet to finish the hole. Cut a 7" piece of cord and slide it through the finished hole. Use the cord to tie the label the gift. Use a permanent pen to write **To: and From:** on the back of the label.






Placement Drawing






Placement Drawing
