Visitors and Student Pick-up

All visitors to Grant Elementary School will need to sign in at the main office and get a visitor’s pass. If you are picking up your child for an early release or from the clinic, you will be asked to present photo identification. If you are picking up a child, please remain in the office area. We will call down to your child’s classroom and he/she can meet you in the office. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation regarding our school’s safety procedures.

Lunch Information and Student Fee Payment System

'Pay For It'

"Pay For It" gives parents the ability to see their child's cafeteria account balance, what their child has purchased for the last 30 days and set up low balance e-mail reminders. Parents can put money in their child's account, on-line, using credit cards or an electronic check. This account can be used to pay school fees, lunch fees, activity fees and fundraisers. **For more information on how to sign up for this service, please see go to www.weschools.org and click on the 'PAY FOR IT' link under the 'Parents' tab.** The sticker attached to the front of this packet has information needed to link your child to the account you create.

There is also information regarding free and reduced lunch on the 'Pay For It' site. Paper copies of the free and reduced lunch form will be sent home the first week of school. Applications from 2013-2014 school year are good until Sept. 30th. You **MUST** fill out a new application to receive this program after Sept. 30th.

Breakfast is available before school at a cost of \$1.90 / Reduced cost is \$0.30 and the cost for **lunch is \$2.85 / Reduced Cost is \$0.40**. Menus will be available soon!

School Hours, Drop off and Pick up, and Child Care

- Children can arrive at 8:45 AM and wait until the 1st bell rings (students come inside if weather is severe). School **begins** at 9:00 AM.
 - School ends at 2:53 pm. Buses use the bus loop in the back of the school to pick up students. Parents pick up students at the front entrance. **Please see the enclosed map for pick up and drop off procedures.** Also, please follow the traffic pattern and be patient! Safety is our main priority!
 - Before and after school childcare will be available this year **at Grant Elementary School**. This program will be offered through the YMCA. Please visit our website for more information on this new program.

Attendance Line and Early Release

- If your child will be absent from school, please call the school's attendance line at, **440-283-4085** (24 hour line). If we do not receive a call from you, and your child is absent, we will call you to verify the absence. This is for the safety of your child.
 - If your child needs to be released from school prior to dismissal, please send in a signed note with your child's name, child's teacher and the time they will be leaving school early. The office gets these notes first thing in the morning from your child's teacher. It is **very** helpful to know **ahead of time** when a student is leaving. It helps us keep everyone **SAFE** and have your student ready when you arrive!

Please call the Transportation office at 440-975-3736 if you have not received a bus pass by **August 21st**. **If changes occur during the school year with your child's transportation needs, please inform Transportation and the school office so we can accommodate you.**

School Clinic and Medications

For a child to take any over the counter medication a form must be filled in IN ADVANCE of the child taking the medication. **ANY doctor prescribed medication** given to children at school requires a physician's note.
