2. Did the authors include the appropriate studies? (The authors should list their criteria for inclusion/exclusion and report excluded studies with the rationale for exclusion)			
3. Did the authors appropriately assess and document the quality of the included studies? (Look in the “ methods ” section to see if multiple authors evaluated each study using a standard critical appraisal method that included assessing randomization, blinding, etc. If authors of the summary resource didn’t critically appraise the original research, it severely limits the validity of their summary.) 4. Did the authors consider the quality of studies when analyzing the data and formulating conclusions? (For example: Did they limit their analysis to only the higher quality studies? Or did they weight the higher quality studies more than low quality studies when making
