

Reed College Financial Aid Application Checklist Continuing Students: 2010-11

- ☐ File the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by April 1, 2010 (processed report must be received in the financial aid office by May 1, 2010). The FAFSA is an online application available at www.fafsa.gov.
- ☐ File the College Scholarship Service (CSS) PROFILE by April 1, 2010 (processed report must be received in the financial aid office by May 1, 2010). The CSS PROFILE is an online application available at www.collegeboard.com.
- ☐ Submit a signed copy of parent 2009 IRS income tax return to the financial aid office by May 1, 2010. If the tax return will not be available by May 1, submit a copy of the 2009 tax extension (Form 4868).
- ☐ Submit copies of all parent 2009 W-2 and 1099 statement(s) to the financial aid office by May 1, 2010.
- ☐ Submit a signed copy of student 2009 IRS income tax return to the financial aid office by May 1, 2010. If the tax return will not be available by May 1, submit a copy of the 2009 tax extension (Form 4868).
- ☐ Submit copies of all student 2009 W-2 and 1099 statements to the financial aid office by May 1, 2010.
- ☐ Submit a completed 2010-11 Verification Worksheet, **including student's AND one parent's signature**, to the financial aid office by May 1, 2010. The Verification Worksheet is available at <http://www.reed.edu/financialaid/forms.html>.

LATE APPLICATIONS HAVE CONSEQUENCES:

Applications received by:

May 1 – (On Time) = Full Consideration
May 2 – June 1 – (Late 1) = 10-20% Reduction in Reed Grant
June 2 – July 1 – (Late 2) = 20-40% Reduction in Reed Grant
After July 1 – NO INSTITUTIONAL AID, federal aid only
