The course prepares students for certification as an Emergency Medical Technician- Basic through the Utah Bureau of EMS.

What are the prerequisites for ESEC 1140-Emergency Medical Technician-Basic?

There are no prerequisites, but you must be 18 years of age within 120 days of course completion.

What is the class schedule for ESEC 1140-Emergency Medical Technician-Basic?

What is covered in ESEC 3060-Advanced Emergency Medical Technician?

The course prepares students for certification as an Advanced Emergency Medical Technician through the Utah Bureau of EMS.

- Advanced airway management
- Intravenous access
- Medication administration
- Cardiac rhythm interpretation
- Advanced medical skills

What is the prerequisite for ESEC 3060-Advanced Emergency Medical Technician?

- Utah EMT-Basic Certification
- Entrance Exam

What is the class schedule for ESEC 3060-Advanced Emergency Medical Technician?

- Offered both Fall and Spring semesters
- Tuesdays, Thursdays from 6 pm – 10 pm, Saturdays – TBA

How much do these classes cost?

Tuition:

- This is a 9 credit class

Course/Lab Fees:

- Approximately \$110.00

Certification Fees:

- \$145.00 for Utah residents, \$180.00 for a student who has lived out-of-state of Utah anytime in the last 5 years.
