

RECORD CHECK CERTIFICATE CHECKLIST

If a driver's criminal record check or driver record abstract includes **any of the items in this checklist**, a driver is **not eligible** to drive a passenger directed vehicle under the Passenger Transportation Regulation (Section 12.6 – 12.7) and should **not** be issued a Record Check Certificate.

Criminal Record Check

A conviction, **within the previous 10 years**, for any offence under the *Criminal Code* or *Controlled Drugs and Substances Act (Canada)*

An outstanding charge for any offence under the *Criminal Code* or *Controlled Drugs and Substances Act (Canada)*

Not eligible

A conviction for any of the following offences under the *Criminal Code* **regardless of time frame**, including any predecessors (previous versions) of these offences:

- Not eligible** Air or maritime safety offences (sections 76 to 78)
- Not eligible** Offences involving explosives (sections 79 to 82.6)
- Not eligible** Terrorism (part II.1)
- Not eligible** Use of firearm in commission of offence (section 85)
- Not eligible** Possession of weapon for dangerous purpose (section 88)
- Not eligible** Robbery to steal firearm (section 98.1)
- Not eligible** Criminal negligence, murder, infanticide, bodily harm (sections 219 to 248)
- Not eligible** Assault offences (sections 267 to 269.1)
- Not eligible** Assaulting peace officer (sections 270.01 and 270.02)
- Not eligible** Kidnapping, trafficking in persons, hostage taking (sections 279 to 281)
- Not eligible** Hate crimes (sections 318 and 319)
- Not eligible** Robbery and extortion (sections 343 to 346)
- Not eligible** Breaking and entering offences (sections 348 to 351)
- Not eligible** Mischief causing actual danger to life (section 430 (2))
- Not eligible** Arson - disregard for human life (section 433)

A conviction for any offence of a sexual nature under the *Criminal Code* **regardless of time frame**, including any predecessors (previous versions) of these offences:

- Not eligible** Sexual interference, sexual touching, sexual exploitation (sections 151 to 153.1)
- Not eligible** Child pornography (section 163.1)
- Not eligible** Sexual assault (sections 271 to 273)
- Not eligible** Removal of child from Canada for sexual purposes (section 273.3)
- Not eligible** Obtaining, producing or advertising sexual services (section 286.1 to 286.4)

Driver Record Abstract

An outstanding charge of conviction, prohibition, or suspension of any of the following, including any predecessors (previous versions) of these convictions, prohibitions, or suspensions, renders a driver **not eligible**:

Any administrative driving prohibitions, within the **previous 3 years**, of the *Motor Vehicle Act*:

- Not eligible** Where there is an unsatisfied judgement (section 91 (1))
- Not eligible** Relating to fitness or ability to drive (section 92)
- Not eligible** Prohibition against driving by superintendent (section 93 (1))
- Not eligible** Court prohibition against driving (section 94.2)
- Not eligible** Effect of notice of driving prohibition (section 98 (2))
- Not eligible** Automatic prohibition against driving on conviction (section 99 (2))
- Not eligible** Against driving for failing to stop (section 100 (3))
- Not eligible** Effect of immediate roadside driving prohibition (section 215.43 (1)(b) or (c), (2) or (2.1))
- Not eligible** Unlicensed driver prohibition (section 251 (4))

2 or more driving suspensions, within the **previous 3 years**, under the 12-hour suspension (section 90.3 (5)) of the *Motor Vehicle Act* or similar matter under a jurisdiction other than British Columbia

- Not eligible**

A driving suspension, within the **previous 3 years**, under the 12-hour suspension (section 90.3 (5)) AND a driving prohibition, within the **previous 3 years**, under the 24-hour prohibition (section 215 (5)) of the *Motor Vehicle Act* or similar matter under a jurisdiction other than British Columbia

- Not eligible**

A driving prohibition, within the **previous 3 years**, under the 3-day immediate roadside driving prohibition (section 215.43 (1)(a) AND a 12-hour driving suspension (section 90.3 (5)) or 24-hour prohibition (section 215 (5)) **within the previous 3 years** of the *Motor Vehicle Act* or similar matter under a jurisdiction other than British Columbia

- Not eligible**

2 or more driving prohibitions, within the **previous 3 years**, under the 24-hour prohibition (section 215 (5)) of the *Motor Vehicle Act* or similar matter under a jurisdiction other than British Columbia

- Not eligible**

Violation tickets respecting driving records within the **previous 2 years**:

- Not eligible** 4 or more convictions resulting in demerit points (driver penalty points) for offences listed in the Point System (Division 28) of the *Motor Vehicle Act* Regulations or similar matter under a jurisdiction other than British Columbia

Note: Consequences associated with any false or misleading representation of information in this checklist may lead to a violation ticket, administrative penalty, or cancellation of a licence under the passenger transportation laws.
