PRE-KINDERGARTEN (AGES 4-5) AND KINDERGARTEN (AGES 5-6)

- Completed Application and £250 fee (non-refundable)
- Copy of the student's passport on application and relevant visa for entrance to the UK before the start of school
- Early Childhood Questionnaire – completed by student's parent
- Teacher reference form – completed by student's classroom teacher
- Any Individual Education Plans (IEP), psychological assessments, occupational therapy, language reports or medical reports
- Any available school records or information regarding any support received in school

GRADES 1-4 (AGES 6-10)

- Completed Application and £250 fee (non-refundable)
- Copy of the student's passport on application and relevant visa for entrance to the UK before the start of school
- Two teacher reference forms – completed by student's current teachers
- School records from previous three years and any standardised test results
- Any Individual Education Plans (IEP), psychological assessments, occupational therapy, language reports or medical reports
- Any available school records or information regarding any support received in school

GRADES 5-8 (AGES 10-14)

- Completed Application and £250 fee (non-refundable)
- Copy of the student's passport on application and relevant visa for entrance to the UK before the start of school
- Student Questionnaire - completed by the student in their own handwriting
- Two teacher reference forms – completed by student's current teachers
- School records from previous three years and any standardised test results
- English as an Additional Language (EAL) testing may be required
- Any Individual Education Plans (IEP), psychological assessments, occupational therapy, language reports or medical reports
- Any available school records or information regarding any support received in school

GRADES 9-12 (AGES 14-18)

- Completed Application and £250 fee (non-refundable)
- Copy of the student's passport on application and relevant visa for entrance to the UK before the start of school
- Student Questionnaire - completed by the student in their own handwriting
- Two teacher reference forms – completed by student's current teachers
- School records from previous three years and any standardised test results
- Students applying for the International Baccalaureate Diploma need to complete an IB Application form
- English as an Additional Language (EAL) testing may be required
- Any Individual Education Plans (IEP), psychological assessments, occupational therapy, language reports or medical reports
- Any available school records or information regarding any support received in school
