5 'More' Things You Have to do Before You Enroll

1. **Establish your official U of M email account**

Email is the official communication method of the University of Memphis. The email account is free to set up, and you can take care of it online. Visit: iam.memphis.edu and click on Initialize Your Account. Enter your unique code.

Future correspondence (registration information, notification of transfer credit evaluations, etc.) will be sent to this university email address. If you already have a U of M email account, please move forward with logging into your personal page. Contact the Help Desk (901.678.8888) if you cannot access that account.

2. **myMemphis: Log into your personal page**

All students use myMemphis to access their personalized resource at the University of Memphis. Through this page, students will register for their courses as well as accept scholarships and financial aid. Visit my.memphis.edu for details.

3. **Review your Terms and Conditions**

Locate the "Account\$" tab and select "Financial Aid Awards" after you have logged into the system. Select the 2019-2020 Aid Year to review your awards and the terms to the scholarship.

4. **Accept your offer**

Review the "Terms and Conditions" and accept the requirements. Your "Accept Award Offer" tab will become available and you can accept your respective award.
