

CHECKLIST FOR CLINICAL PARTICIPATION

CRIMINAL BACKGROUND SCREENING

- All students must consent to a criminal background screening through CastleBranch.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

- All students must provide a signed, complete physical examination form verification of a physical examination performed by a licensed primary care provider within the last 12 months prior to admission.

CPR CERTIFICATION

- All students must successfully complete Basic Life Support (BLS) course administered by American Heart Association (AHA). Students must keep a copy of a current AHA BLS CPR certification on file with the college. CPR certification expires two (2) years from date issued.

DRUG SCREENING

- Students must complete a drug screening through CastleBranch.
