

MY Behavior Report

Directions:

When students misbehave, provide an opportunity for them to reflect on their behavior. This can be accomplished by having them fill out "My Behavior Report".

1. The first portion allows for the student to pick a specific behavior that was problematic.
2. The second section asks the student to express how they feel about this situation.
3. Third, students think about what actions need to be present in order to make a good choice.
4. On the back of the report, there are three sections for a written response from the student, teacher, and parent.
5. This form also requests that parents sign to confirm receipt. Students are then required to bring this form back to school the next school day.
6. The teacher can place the report in the student's file and have an easily accessible record of behavior incidents.




