STANDARD PROVIDER AGREEMENT

This agreement for professional services is made this _____ day of _____, 20_____, by and between _____, (hereinafter referred to as "Artist / Provider") and _____, Sponsoring Club/Organization of Skidmore College, (hereinafter referred to as "Sponsor") and does hereby establish the following terms, rights, and liabilities for the parties involved for the production of this specific engagement. Artist/Provider remains an independent contractor executing this agreement for the specific services indicated. All binding items are subject to the laws of the State of New York. All means of production must comply with existing Skidmore College policies and procedures. This agreement is required even if the Artist/Provider provides a contract. In the event of a conflict, all terms contained in this contract supersede those of any other contract or agreement for the same service. The Artist/Provider represents that no monetary or other form of remuneration has been given, offered or promised to anyone in order to include the college organization to enter into this agreement, no remuneration shall be given, offered or promised to any agent, servant, employee, officer, director or student of the College.

Artist technical Rider must be submitted at least one week prior to show date for review.

a. **Sponsor** agrees to provide the specified venue appropriately cleaned, heated, adequately lit, and available up to 2 hours prior to show time. Sponsor agrees to make a dressing room or other private space available to the performer for a minimum usage of up to 2 hours prior and 1 hour after performance.

10. Miscellaneous:

a. In the event that this agreement shall be prevented by any unexpected and disruptive event, or other proven cause beyond the control of the "Artist/Provider" or the College, it is agreed that neither party will be held liable for the balance of the agreement.

b. Artist/Provider agrees to take all reasonable precautions in connection with the use of the facilities in order to protect the health and safety of the College community or any person(s) attending or occupying the facilities, and to eliminate or minimize danger from all hazards to life and property, and agree to comply with all health, safety and fire protection rules, and shall assure compliance with all applicable state and federal statutes and regulations.

c. The College will not be responsible for loss of, or damage to, any personal property of the Artist/Provider, its guests, agents, employees, or invitees located on Skidmore College property, before, during, or after the term of the Agreement.

11. Insurance: The Artist/Provider shall maintain insurance (*Insurance Requirements as directed by the office of Leadership Activities*) for such lengths of time as is necessary to cover any and all claims arising in connection with this agreement. Artist shall also furnish a Certificate of Insurance as evidence that coverage are in full force and effect and shall name Skidmore College as additional insured.

12. Indemnity Agreement: To the fullest extent permitted by Law, the Artist/Provider and all Representatives, will indemnify and hold harmless Skidmore College, and its officers, employees, agents, volunteers and students from and against claims, damages, demands, judgments, losses and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, arising out of or resulting from the negligent or wrongful acts or omissions of Artist/Provider or their employees or agents.
